ON
THE ISLAMIC OFFICE FOR THE BOYCOTT OF ISRAEL

The Forty Fifth Session of the Council of Foreign Ministers, (Session of Islamic Values for Sustainable Peace, Solidarity and Development), held in Dhaka, People's Republic of Bangladesh, from 19-20 Sha'ban 1439 H (5-6 May 2018),

Proceeding from the principles and objectives enshrined in the Charter of the Organization of the Islamic Cooperation (OIC);

Mindful of the existing cooperation and coordination between the Islamic Office for the Boycott of Israel (IBO) at the OIC General Secretariat and the Arab Office for the Boycott of Israel at the General Secretariat of the League of Arab States, in favour of an optimal implementation of the principles and provisions of the boycott of Israel;

Based on all the relevant Islamic resolutions, in particular Res. No. 1/44-IBO, adopted by the Forty-Fourth Session of the Council of Foreign Ministers, held in Abidjan, Republic of Côte d'Ivoire, on 10-11 July 2017;

Having considered the report of the Secretary General on the IBO;

1. **Recalls** the Jakarta Declaration on Palestine and Al-Quds Ash-Sharif, adopted during the Fifth Extraordinary Islamic Summit on Palestine and Al-Quds Ash-Sharif on 7 March 2016, containing commitments to pursue concrete actions to be collectively taken towards the realization of the inalienable rights of the Palestinian People, including calls upon the international community to support the boycott of products produced in or by the illegal Israeli settlements;
2. **Calls on** Member States and the wider international community to ban the products of the illegal Israeli settlements from entering their markets, take measures against individuals and entities involved in or beneficiaries of the perpetuation of occupation and settlement regime, and include settler leaders, including the hordes of terrorist settlers, on the list of terrorists and criminals wanted for international prosecution by States and international organizations; **stresses** the need to take legal action vis-à-vis these crimes at all international fora and relevant organizations; and **pays tribute** to those Member States that have taken action to boycott the products originating from Israeli settlements,

3. **Invited** Member States to commit to the implementation of the provisions of the Islamic Boycott of Israel and to consider the legislations and the rules and regulations governing the boycott action (general principles of the boycott, the Islamic law, and the OIC Summit and CFM resolutions on the boycott of Israel, as part of their national legislations in force.
4. **Requests** the IBO with the assistance of professional consultant in consultation with the State of Palestine to produce an updated and credible list of products of illegal Israeli settlements as a common reference for the OIC Member States in implementing this resolution at national level.
5. **Commends** the existing cooperation between the IBO at the OIC General Secretariat and the Arab Office for the Boycott of Israel at the General Secretariat of the League of Arab States in favour of an optimal implementation of the principles and provisions of the boycott of Israel.
6. **Emphasizes** support for the IBO to enable it to perform its duties and tasks aimed at increasing the efficiency of the boycott of Israel in Islamic States.
7. **Requests** the Secretary General to follow up the implementation of the present resolution and report thereon to the Forty-Sixth Session of the CFM.
